Airfield – The Clerk gave an update on the appeal against noise abatement notices by Elvington Park. The appeal will be heard at York Crown Court, sitting at Harrogate Magistrates Court, from 22nd to 24th November.

Cllr Wilson suggested various work that should be undertaken to improve the triangle. Cllr Wilson also pointed out that there may be a threat to the health of the horse chestnut trees.
