It was agreed that the Parish Council would not be able to run the Under 5's group.

Concerns from parishioner about the removal of traffic calming measures near the school: CYC will replace the speed cushions which were removed so that resurfacing works could be carried out once the new surface has settled. A request for a speed survey has been made by a parishioner. Cllr Laverack pointed out that the 'traffic calming' measure in the centre of the village, is a 'build-out', designed to allow a safe crossing for schoolchildren. It has inadvertently also encouraged vehicles to slow down. Although the Council could see the benefit of a chicane or similar to slow traffic down between the school and the Dr's surgery, given we are still awaiting confirmation of a crossing at the school, it was felt that this request would have to wait."
